



Background

The Nigeria Field Epidemiology and Laboratory Training Programme (NFELTP) was established in October 2008 to develop a self-sustaining institutionalized capacity to train public health leaders in field epidemiology and field-oriented public health laboratory practice, and to provide epidemiological services to the public health system at federal, state, and local levels. The programme works with the Ministries of Health and Ministries of Agriculture and Rural Development at the Federal and State levels to develop public health capacity, strengthen health systems and respond to disease epidemics and other priority public health problems in the country.
